Windrush awards Rules and judging Criteria

Nominations must be for an adult who was a part of the Windrush generation 1948-1971 or before.

Nominations must be for those who made a contribution in either Kent or Medway. The nominees must be from the Black African or Caribbean community or mixed parentage communities of African or Caribbean descent.

Awards can be given to relatives of any person of that generation who may be deceased as a posthumous award.

Multiple nominations for 1 person will not be accepted in different categories.

The achievement must comply with one of the categories stated.

The judging panel will consist of MACA members and independent members.

In the event of a possible conflict of interest, the panel may decide that a judge cannot sit on the judging panel if a nominee is known to them.

Nominations will be accepted from organisations, individuals or families. The judging panel's decisions will be final.

1. **Health**

Awarded to people who have contributed to health services in Kent or Medway. In recognition of pioneers, long service, dedication and commitment to health services, or promoting health and well-being. This can be an individual or an organisation.

2. **Armed forces**

Awarded to people who have contributed to the armed forces in recognition of pioneers, long service, dedication and commitment to the armed forces.

3. **3 Religion**

Individuals or organisations that have contributed to the growth of religion in Kent and Medway for the Black community.

4. **Sports**

For individuals or organisations who have achieved or contributed to sport

5. **The Arts**

For individuals or organisations who have achieved or contributed to the arts

6. **Community/society**

For individuals or organisations who have achieved or contributed to
The local community, or notable people who lived in or worked in Kent or Medway
